BIOGRAPHY

Chan Iulian is a freelance saxophonist/flutist based in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. He graduated with a Masters degree in Jazz Performance from Queens College in NYC, where he studied with jazz greats Antonio Hart, Michael Mossman, Howard Brofsky and David Berkman.

Julian has been actively performing, since 2001, in Malaysia and other parts of the Asian region, such as

Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, Taiwan and China. He has performed with various Malaysian jazz luminaries - Michael Veerapen, David Gomes, Junji Delfino, Jose Thomas among others; performed and toured with Chinese international pop artistes such as Jonathan Lee (李宗盛) and Jeff Chang (张信哲),

as well as Malaysian pop artistes such as Ning Baizura, Dayang Nurfaizah, Anuar Zain, Sheila Majid, Sharizan Borhan, among others. He has also established himself well in the Malaysian music scene, whether as a sideman and as a bandleader. He is currently an active member of one of Malaysia's sought after jazz band, WVC TRiO+1, as well as his own New Quartet.

Julian has been involved in a large variety of projects, ranging from club shows, concerts, festivals, album and commercial recordings, music tours, as well as theatre.
